



THE FIR ISSUE RAISED INSIDE THE ASSEMBLY

Buxar MLA Anand Mishra officially raised a critical issue in the Bihar Vidhan Sabha regarding how maliciously filed or unverified First Information Reports (FIRs) destroy the careers of young job aspirants.

Drawing heavily from his professional experience as a former Indian Police Service (IPS) officer, he argued that a single police complaint should not automatically derail a hard-working student's future before any guilt is legally proven.

The Core Problem Raised by the MLA

- **The Character Certificate Barrier:** MLA Anand Mishra pointed out that under existing systems, if an individual has any FIR registered against their name, local police stations automatically withhold or issue a negative Character Certificate (Charitra Praman Patra).
- **Weaponization of FIRs by Rivals:** He highlighted that in rural and semi-urban pockets of Bihar, malicious neighbors or local rivals often file completely false or exaggerated FIRs over minor land and personal disputes out of sheer jealousy.
- **Loss of hard-earned Job Opportunities:** Talented and innocent youth who study rigorously to pass competitive state examinations such as the Bihar Public Service Commission (BPSC), state police forces, or banking sectors lose their job appointments purely because a pending FIR stalls their background verification. By the time a routine police investigation proves the case false, the recruitment timeline closes, and the candidate is permanently deprived of the opportunity.

Key Demands & Policy Reforms Proposed in the House

To correct this systemic injustice, the MLA formally proposed a series of strategic legal and administrative adjustments to the Bihar government:



- **FIR is Not Proof of Guilt:** He strongly emphasized to the assembly that the mere registration of an FIR does not make a person a criminal.
- **Conditional Selection Framework:** He proposed that if a candidate has qualified for a government job but faces a pending FIR where charges have not yet been proven or framed in court, they should be allowed to join the service conditionally.
- **Post-Verification Check:** If the subsequent police investigation or legal charge sheet establishes actual criminal guilt, the government reserves the full right to take disciplinary action and terminate the individual during their training or probationary period.

Impact and Reception

The speech gained massive traction across digital platforms and resonated deeply with the student and aspirant community of Bihar. Furthermore, the impact transcended state borders, drawing widespread gratitude from individuals in Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, and several other states, who reached out to convey their thanks for raising this crucial issue in the house. By focusing on the structural overlap between police procedures and employment laws, his intervention forced the assembly to deliberate on a streamlined background-verification policy that balances public safety with the rights of innocent job seekers.

महोदय,

मैं बिहार विधानसभा की प्रक्रिया एवं कार्य संचालन नियमावली के नियम-104 के तहत लोक महत्व के विषय पर सरकार का ध्यान आकृष्ट करना चाहता हूँ:

"राज्य के हजारों मेधावी युवाओं-युवतियों जिनका चयन बिहार पुलिस, शिक्षक भर्ती एवं बीपीएससी जैसी सरकारी नौकरियों में होने के पश्चात भी चरित्र सत्यापन के दौरान मामूली विवादों के कारण उनकी 'ज्वाइनिंग' अनिश्चितकाल के लिए रोक दी जाती है। ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में आपसी रंजिश या छोटे-मोटे जमीन विवाद के लंबित मामलों (FIR) के कारण अभ्यर्थियों को 'अयोग्य' मान लिया जाता है। केवल प्राथमिकी दर्ज होने पर नियुक्ति से वंचित करना 'जीविका के अधिकार' एवं प्राकृतिक न्याय के विरुद्ध है, क्योंकि कानूनन दोष सिद्ध होने तक व्यक्ति निर्दोष है।

अतः मैं सरकार से राज्य के चयनित उम्मीदवारों के 'ज्वाइनिंग' में चरित्र प्रमाण पत्र के संबंध में निर्गत आदेश के कारण आ रही बाधा को दूर करने के लिए नियम में तत्काल बदलाव कर लंबित चयनित अभ्यर्थियों के अविलंब ज्वाइनिंग कराने के लिए नयी नियमावली बनाने हेतु सरकार का ध्यान आकृष्ट करता हूँ।"
